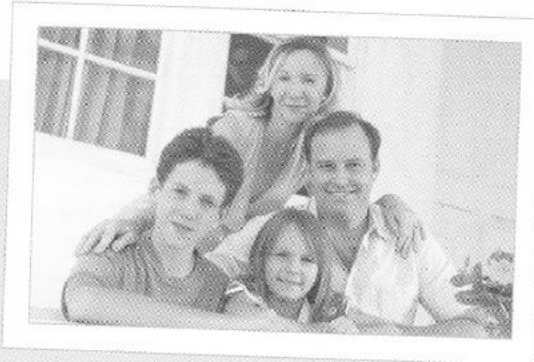


My name's Ivana.
